We continue to develop our breakfast and after school provision. Look out for a letter detailing our the school clubs on offer from January.


We are delighted to be able to offer gymnastics club on an ongoing basis.













BARCAPLE RESIDENTIAL

Good attendance habits impact positively on friendships and attainment. Thanks for your support in helping us to achieve excellent overall attendance at Bowness.



Owls: 80% Ospreys: 95% Kestrels 94%







WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING?
