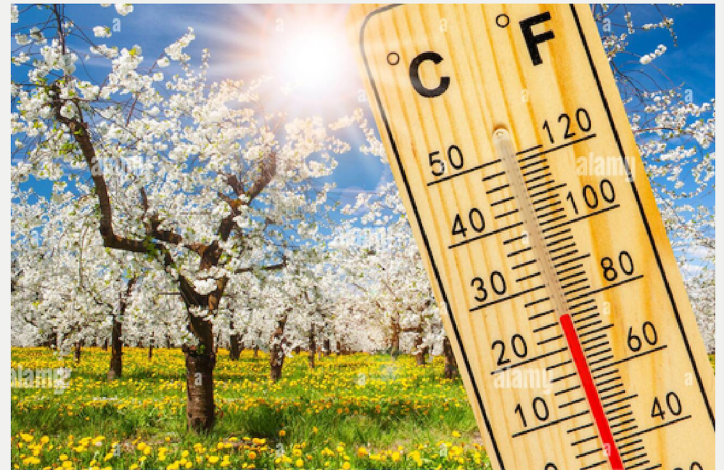

PETITION

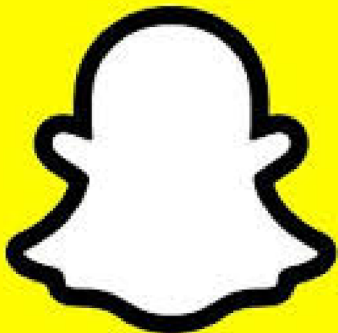
We and the broader local community remain concerned about dangerous driving in the village.
