ONLINE SAFETY

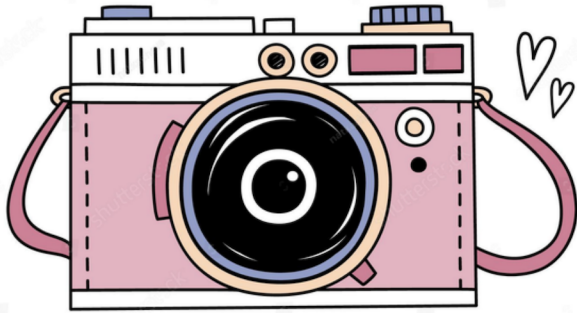
I am attaching an important information sheet about Roblox.
