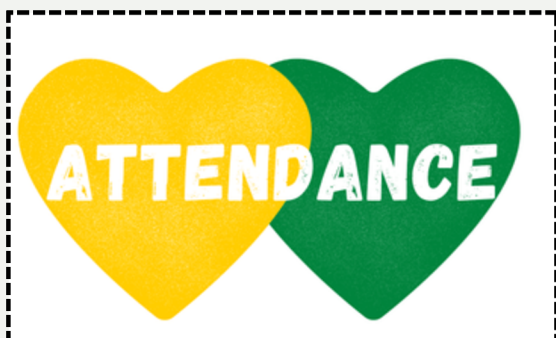
CAREERS EVENT
