



Early Years Curriculum

Our Nursery curriculum is the Early Years Curriculum based on 7 areas of learning as seen above. In school our Early Years team base their learning activities on the understanding that every child's individuality is to be cherished (the unique child) and so learning and development will be achieved in different ways and at different rates.



We know that children learn to be strong and independent from a base of loving and secure relationships, so we actively seek partnership with every child's first teacher—their parents and carers—in order to develop these positive relationships. All our nursery children have a key worker who develops a warm, trusting relationship with them, giving them the reassurance to feel safe and cared for. By giving the children a rich and varied learning environment, making use of both inside and outside areas, we believe we support every child in their learning and development. Activities are planned by observing the children in order to understand their individual needs.

We offer wrap around care to the Pre School on site.

There is a breakfast club in school from 7:45am at a cost of **£3** per day.

Our afternoon session (**£12**) runs from 11:45am—3:15pm and includes lunch.

Then, there is after school provision with our After School Club themed nights on a Monday and Tuesday (until 5pm) at £5 per session; gymnastics club on Wednesday and wrap around care can be available on Thursdays and Fridays.
